Auto-Approval Prerequisites Updates

General Overview

The purpose of this task is to enhance the Auto-Approval Prerequisites to check that the defined minimum/maximum ages are a subset of the age range defined in the Class details and notify the user if the changes would result in invalid Auto-Approval ages.

How will this benefit me?

This will ensure that any time an Auto-Approval Prerequisite is set based on age that the age is not outside the age range defined in the Class details, and therefore that the system is not presented with a scenario where enrollments cannot be auto-approved.

Where will I see these changes?

These changes will affect the Office Portal; in particular the Auto-Approval Prerequisites and anywhere they can be set (class "Auto-Approval" tab, QuickEdit tool, or Mass Copy tool).

What is being changed/added?

If the Auto-Approval age is being updated manually, the system will verify that it is within the age range specified in the class details.

- If the specified age is within the age range specified in the class details, then the class can be saved without any issues.

- If the specified age is outside the age range specified in the class details, then we will highlight the field in red and present a warning message that prevents customers from saving until they make the necessary corrections.

If the Auto-Approval age is being updated via QuickEdit/Mass Copy, the system will verify that it is within the age range specified in the class details.

- The system will FIRST check the GENERAL tab to see if any minimum/maximum age values are also being edited in the REQUIREMENTS section.
 - ❖ If so, the system will validate the new Auto-Approval age based on these values.
 - ❖ If not, the system will validate the new Auto-Approval age based on the values that are currently saved to the selected class(es).
 - If the specified age is within the specified age range, then the class can be updated without any issues.
 - If the specified age is outside the age range specified in the class details, then the system will continue with the QuickEdit process for any updates that are valid. However, any classes that would result in invalid Auto-Approval ages WILL NOT be updated and those classes will be included in an Exception Report generated in the Background Tasks.

How does this work with existing settings?

This enhances current settings but does not add any new settings to be defined by the user.
